Checklist for Chinese X2 Visa

Short-term study visa (X2-visa) is issued to those intending to study in China for a period no more than 180 days.

Please prepare all the documents in the following order:

Basic documents:

- Original passport and one copy
 Valid for at least 6 months from the date of application, with 2 blank visa pages
- 2. South African ID/PR/VISA (valid for at least 6 months)/last entry stamp page copy
- 3. Visa Application Form completed and signed
- 4. One recent color photo affixed on the visa application form
- 5. Latest Chinese visa copy (if any)

Please prepare the following supporting documents:

- 1. To public school:
- (1) Original or photocopy of Admission Notice
- (2) Photocopy of QD or JW202 form
- 2. To private school or training institution:
- (1) Original or photocopy of Admission Notice and copy of valid school license and registration
- (2) Proof of payment of school fees, i.e. Chinese Invoice issued by tax bureau, or Bank Transfer record to the school

Important Notice:

- 1. All study visa applicants should write a statement mainly including the following contents on item 3.7 of the visa application form: I know that holding a study visa cannot take any employment paid or unpaid in China. Otherwise, I will undertake all legal consequences by myself.
- 2. If the applicants are late for the registration deadline indicated on the Admission Notice, they should contact the school for issuing them a formal letter of extending their registration date.
- 3. The visa officer may ask the applicant to provide any other documents and information as well as call the applicant for an interview, and reserves the right to

- decide on whether or not to issue the visa and on its validity, duration of stay and number of entries.
- 4. All supporting documents must be translated into Chinese or English, and full name of applicant must appear.
- 5. The Chinese Consulate-General will not return documents from files; therefore all original documents will be returned once the copies have been verified at counters.
